## **EMPLOYMENT TRAINING PROGRAMS**

Professional Mastery of Office Technology for Employment (ProMOTE): Provides advanced assistive technology training using the most common office software programs – Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint – as well as instruction in internet research and creating accessible documents.

**Contract Management Support:** A unique partnership with the Defense Acquisition University provides the technical training and skills needed for career opportunities in contract administration.

<u>Information Assurance/Cybersecurity</u>: Provides participants with the knowledge and experience needed for A+, Network+, and Security+ certification by the Computer Technology Industry Association (Comp TIA).
